The qualifying deadlines for the Congressional races have passed. The Democratic candidates are:

CD-1: Gay Valimont

CD-6: Purvi Bangdiwala, George Selmont, Josh Weil

The CD-6 Special Election Primary will take place on **1/28/25**. CD-1 will not have a Primary Election. FDP will schedule meetings with affected DECs to talk through how we can best support you. See details below in the “Data Updates” section of this newsletter on VBM request data details.



DEC and State Party Reorganization

Democratic Executive Committees (DECs) are currently reorganizing and electing their leadership as outlined by the Florida Statutes and FDP Bylaws. Details regarding the date, location, and time of the State Organizational Meeting will be forthcoming.

Data/VAN Updates

VBM request data for the CD-1 and CD-6 Special Elections is being added to VAN using the statewide ***VBM Thru 2026** activist code 3x weekly (M, W, F). Beginning in January, the early voting module in Create a List will be cleared & reset for the special election primaries. At that time, daily updates to VAN will ensue.

On 11/26/24, the monthly voter file update was processed in VAN. The VAN is now current with the voter file through November 1st. We completed a full update to My Voters that includes all new registrants in the state's current voter rolls & we have updated NCOA certifications in VAN. The next monthly disk is expected to be *shipped* from the FL Division of Elections on 12/18. This disk will include 2024 General Election Results, which we expect to go live in VAN in late December/early January pending DNC processing.
